



# The Borthwick Looking for **Charity Partners**



## THE BORTHWICK MEMORIAL GOLF TOURNAMENT

The Borthwick Memorial Golf Tournament is looking to partner with several new charities starting in 2020 and 2021.

Members with a connection to a local charity may want to consider recommending a charity partner, as the Borthwick Charity Selection Committee plans on conducting interviews this fall with potential candidates.

The committee will select two charities to receive funding beginning in 2020 through 2022 and two charities to begin funding in 2021 through 2023. In the past, charities have received between \$20,000 to \$30,000 per year for three years, based on the funds raised at The Borthwick.

The goal for 2019 is to match or surpass last year's total and raise more than \$200,000 for the charity partners.

Members of the Borthwick Selection Committee include Brian Short, Chair; Chris Bellefeuille, Paul Courneya, Al Scott, Jeff Paikin and Peter Holt (ex-officio).

### Selection Criteria:

1. Must be a registered charity with a charitable number.
2. Must be able to support the event's administration (e.g. printing of brochures,

acquiring sponsors and contributing to the provision of live and silent auction prizes.)

3. Must make a live presentation to the Selection Committee if short-listed for selection.

4. Past recipients are not precluded from applying and receiving funds. The length of sponsorship has been expanded to 3 years.

5. Each charity must have an HGCC member sponsor to serve on the committee for the full funding cycle and have a representative of the charity attend committee meetings as required.

6. Preference is given to local charities (Greater Hamilton) or that have a local project for which funding is required.

**Priority will be given to those local charities who will use the funds to DIRECTLY benefit the needy in our community.**

This year's charity partners include: Ancaster Community Services, Rygiel Supports for Community Living, McMaster Children's Hospital Foundation Pediatric Palliative Care Program, Neighbor to Neighbor Center and the Alzheimer's Society of Hamilton/Halton.

The 49th Annual Dick Borthwick Memorial Golf Tournament will be played Monday, September 9 and we're hoping for sunny skies, warm weather and fun times.
