in their young lives. Yet, they continue to work toward completing their education to build a foundation for their future.

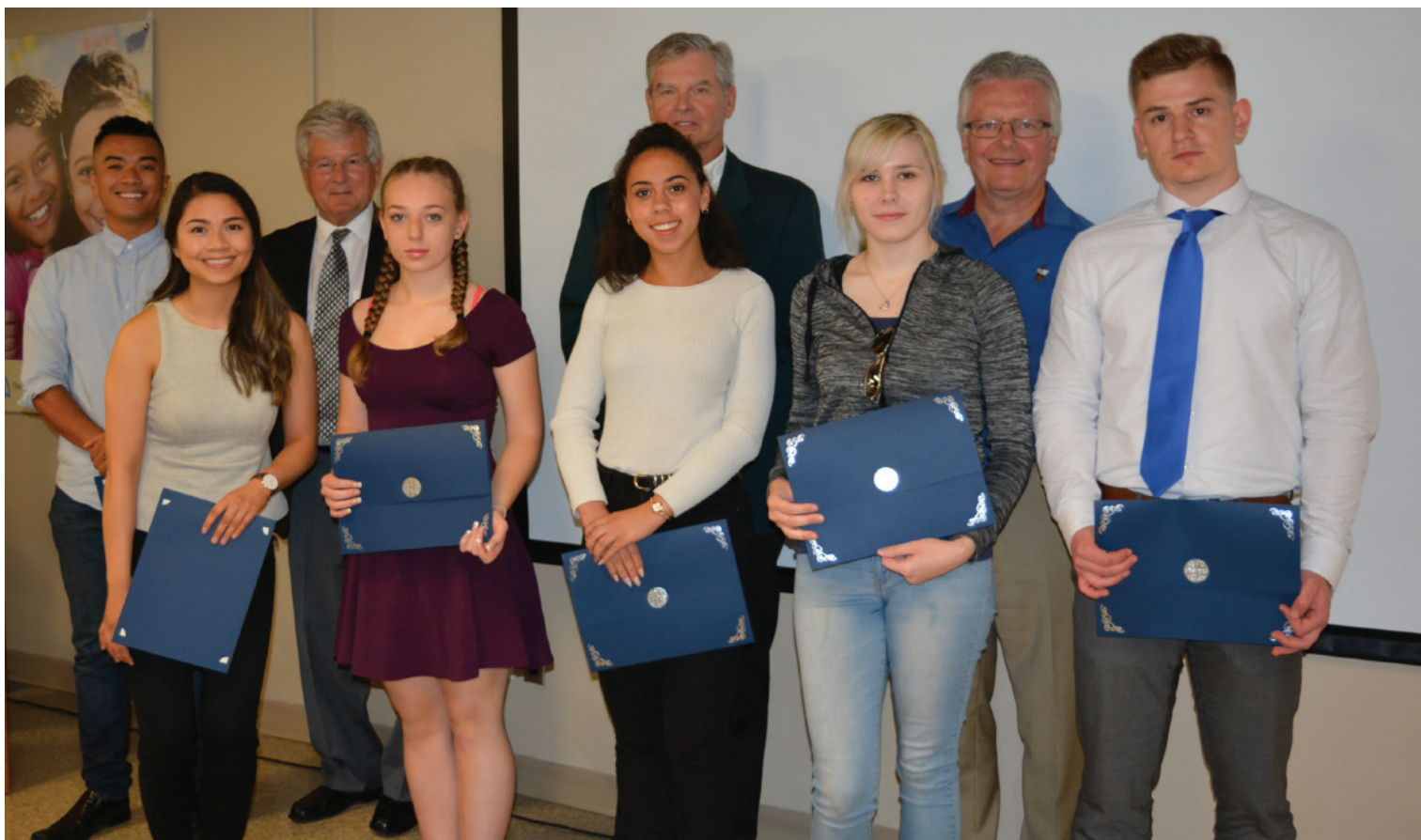
